#### Happy New Year!

We are not far removed from the winter solstice, December 21. It was the shortest day of the year when we have the least daylight. People might complain about how dark it is this time of the year. However, imagine living in the town of Barrow, Alaska, the farthest northern tip of the state of Alaska, above the Arctic Circle. If you think it's dark in Illinois this time of the year, you haven't seen anything. In Barrow, Alaska, the sun set in the afternoon, November 18, 2021 and it doesn't rise again until January 22, 2022. That is 80 days of darkness. 80 days when the sun doesn't shine on the land. The



earth is tilted in such a way Barrow is away from the sun for an extended period of time. The earth spins and the clock turns, but darkness stays constant. Still, when the sun does rise in late January the whole town comes out to celebrate, because finally, there is light again.

Could the prophet Isaiah be speaking to the people of Barrow, Alaska when he writes "Arise, shine, for your light has come!"? It could feel like it, but what God's Word talks about here is a different kind of light, and a different kind of darkness. When this light that God speaks about begins to shine through that darkness the results are much more spectacular and joyful than anything you could experience in northern Alaska. January 6 is Epiphany. What does the word "epiphany" mean? An "epiphany" is when something reveals itself, or shows itself. For example, in Barrow, Alaska, after 80 days of darkness, the sun finally reveals its glory for everyone to see. That's an epiphany. In the church year, the Epiphany season is when The Sun of God reveals his glory for everyone to see. Starting on January 6, for two months, we will be in the Epiphany season. We will live in Epiphany until Ash Wednesday.

Basically, Epiphany is the transformation of darkness to light. Our world can be a very dark place. You can see evidence of that darkness all around. The world often feels dark, lonely and cold, but the joy is that much greater when a person moves out of the darkness and into the light of Christ. This is what happened to the wise men from the East. Every year, these Gentiles from a distant land are the focal point of the Epiphany season. They came from a place where no one knew about Christ. No one knew about the true God who was sending a Savior. But somehow, they knew. And when they saw his star, in some way they knew that the Messiah had come. Therefore, these men left their land to see and worship Christ. They made the long trip to Jerusalem, and they were probably surprised to see that this city was just as dark (spiritually) as the land they had come from.

Many people call Epiphany the "Gentile Christmas," because one of the biggest ideas of the Epiphany season is that Christ is a light for all people, all over the world. Epiphany reminds us that anyone living in the darkness can come and see the glory of God through the person of Jesus Christ. His grace and forgiveness is for every person on this earth. Remember, Barrow, Alaska? While it is true that right now, the sun never rises there. Six months from now, the earth will tilt a different way, and then the sun will never set. From June until August for almost three months, the sun will not stop shining. People call that place "the land of the midnight sun." And so it is with you. Once the grace and mercy and forgiveness of Jesus Christ rises in your life, it will never stop shining. No matter how dark the world gets around you, Christ's love will always shine in your life. May this Epiphany season be for you a time when you see ever more clearly the glory of your Savior, Jesus Christ. "Arise, shine, for your light has come. And the glory of the Lord rises upon you."



GOOD SAMARITAN FUND ~ of the Sandwich-Somonauk Area Churches




