

The word confirmation means "with firmness". Confirmation in The United Methodist Church is a time of intentional preparation, leading to one's first public profession of faith. During this time, young persons "make firm" what has gone before: God's prevenient grace, baptism, the teaching and witness of parents and other persons of faith, the teachings and life together in the church, the student's own growing faith. Youth are invited to claim for themselves the name *Christian* and the name *United Methodist*. Confirmation is a significant step in the journey of faith.



It has been a little while since we've had a confirmation class. In many ways, that only increases the joys and celebrations that confirmation holds this year. We have been a part of a right of passage for young adults in our church. However, it is so much more than just an item to be checked off our life list. Our young adults have taken vows to God and our church. Their faith is not completely 'firmed' yet, but just at the beginning. Confirmation marks the first official evidence of faith in their lives. As such, we do not look to these youth as children any more, but as fellow brothers in Christ.

This is a blessed month for me as a pastor. I got to serve as pastor to three young men on their journey, and as father to two of them. I first want to thank the confirmands; Owen, Christopher, and Eli for their hard work and dedication. You have made me proud. I wish to thank everyone in the church for your support and encouragement of these young adults.

This season is a joyous day for all of us in the church. The confirmands have joined the body of Christ as equal partners in prayer and ministry. I want you to keep them in your prayers. I want you to continue to mentor and guide them as Christians. I want you to remember your confirmation and remember your vows. Below are the vows our confirmands took on Pentecost. Please prayerfully reflect on them and spend some time asking God's guidance in your life in each area.

- † To renounce the spiritual forces of wickedness, reject the evil powers of the world, and repent of one's sin; 'I Do'
- † To accept the freedom and power God gives to resist evil, injustice, and oppression; 'I Do'
- † To confess Jesus Christ as Savior, put one's whole trust in His grace, and promise to serve Him as one's Lord; 'I Do'
- † To remain a faithful member of Christ's holy church and serve as Christ's representative in the world; 'I Will'
- † To be loyal to the United Methodist Church and do all in one's power to strengthen its ministries; 'I Will'
- † To participate faithfully in its ministries by one's prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness; 'I Will'
- † To receive and profess the Christian faith as contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments. 'I Will'

My prayers are with you this summer. Take a little time each day to be in prayer. Perhaps you can take one vow per day and pray on the meaning of the vow. Discern its impact on your faith and your life. End each prayer with a call to action. What action or change is God asking you to commit to while focusing on that specific vow? Find joy and comfort knowing that our vows strengthen our relationship with God. They also strengthen our relationship with each other in Christian community. God is Good!





It is time to plan for a successful 2022 Fair Stand year. We would like to fill as many positions within the schedule as completely as possible. We call everyone to sign up for as many shifts as you can and in the positions you feel the most comfortable.

Remember, it takes forty-nine (49) 5-5 1/2 hour shifts each day to run our stand.

— Thankfully God is with us in all that we do!

Please fill in and return the form to the church or go to the link found on the church website when you are able to work at the fair. Once you click on the link, you will see every work shift and position available for sign up. If a position has a number beside it, that position requires that many people for that shift. After selecting the number of shifts you want hit submit at the bottom. You will be taken to the webpage that will show you the shifts you have signed up for and will be asked for your:

Name, Phone Number & Email.

We also need people who are flexible to float where needed. If an individual is able to commit to a complete 5-5 1/2-hour shift for *three (3) different days* throughout the week, the church will purchase a pass for your use.

We do not receive free passes from the fair — we buy them.

Pies (slice and serve pie and ice cream)

Dining Room (refill condiment counter, wipe tables and trays)

Floater (put anywhere needed)

"Back at the Range" (baking pies at the church, transporting pies to the fair)
