Greetings,

A common question I get each year is... Why does the date of Easter Sunday move around on the calendar each year, and not the same, like say the 1st Sunday of April?

Easter is celebrated on the first Sunday following the full Moon that occurs on or just after the Spring Equinox. The reason the Easter celebration moves around on the calendar is tied to the Jewish celebration of Passover. Passover was the festival happening at the time of the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ. In fact, the Last Supper was a Passover meal. Passover is a week-



long Spring festival that is based on a certain day in the Jewish calendar, which is based on the lunar cycle. Therefore, Passover happens during the first full moon after the Spring Equinox. Passover moves dates and begins Saturday, March 27, 2021. Next year, it will be on Friday, April 15, 2022

For Christians, our faith is deeply rooted and connected to the Jewish faith and traditions. Our communion is an adapted expression by Jesus of the Passover Seder meal with the disciples. He broke from tradition to bless the unleavened bread and the third cup of the Seder meal to become what we now celebrate as Holy Communion. This meal happened during the week of the full moon after the Spring Equinox. Jesus was arrested in the middle of the night and executed on Friday. Normally, a person could last days on the cross, experiencing continual pain. This is what made crucifixion such an infamous form of punishment. The person would die of asphyxiation. However, Jesus died within hours, and his body was able to be buried in the tomb before the beginning of the Sabbath. As the Sabbath concluded, the disciples found the empty tomb on the first day of the week, Sunday. As such, we celebrate the resurrection on Sunday. However, it is not just any Sunday, but the Sunday each year that follows the Passover experience. This year, Easter is April 4, next year, April 17.


I look forward to Easter each year. I love the candy. (I suggest using peeps for S'mores sometime.) I love the Easter flowers, especially lilies. I excitedly look forward to getting together with family over a big ham dinner when we can have a more normal routine again. I love all of those aspects of Easter. However, none of that compares with the best part of Easter. Every Easter we remember the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Easter is about the resurrection of Jesus. However, it is more than that. Jesus did it for me! He did it for you! The German theologian, Jurgen Moltmann expresses in a single sentence the great span from Good Friday to Easter. It is, in fact, a summary of human history, past, present, and future: "God weeps with us so that we may someday laugh with him."

The death of Jesus shows how much God loves us. He walks through whatever valley He needs to in order to reach us. God weeps with you. For every painful experience I have gone through and will go through God weeps with me. As you approach Good Friday, remember that God is with you in the toughest times of your life.

The resurrection of Jesus reminds me that God is bigger than anything! The same God who walks with me through the bad is also strong enough to overcome any enemy, including death. Easter is an annual reminder of how great my God is. God weeps with me on Friday. I will laugh with God on Sunday! God Bless,


