Do you own a Trivial Pursuit game? Do you play it? Do you win? I love Trivial Pursuit and I often do really well in the game. Why? Well, I have a vast knowledge of information that is, well, trivial. Yes, I have some knowledge in important matters. However, I seem to have gathered a collection of information on subjects that have no real relevance in life. Maybe I have shared some of that useless trivial with you. Even in the game Trivial Pursuit I have found some facts that will not improve your life in any way, but are interesting just the same. The Trivial Pursuit board game, created in 1979, is a game in which progress is determined by a player's ability to answer general knowledge and popular culture questions. The object of the game is to answer a correct question in each of 6 categories such as Geography, Sports & Leisure, History, and Science & Nature. The game peaked in 1984 selling 20 million games. Over 100 million games sold, in 26 countries, in 17 languages, with 55 different editions. Some sample questions are:



- What does a Heliologist study? (The Sun)
- What U.S. city was once known as Federal City? (Washington, D.C.)
- What is the crystal anniversary? (A couple celebrating their 15th anniversary)

Exactly what is trivial knowledge? Hebrews 12:1 reminds us to throw off anything that hinders us and run with perseverance the race that is marked out for us. Let's think about that. I love to run. Perhaps you have seen me run through Sandwich sometime. I collect data on my runs with my devices. I can find out my pace, my calories burned, my route, my time, my distance, my speed, etc. This is all great. However, I have found that if I become to focused on all that information it messes up my form and focus. I lose speed. I lose time. I fall behind. The information is nice, but trivial. The only real thing that matters is the finish line.

You focus on a thousand things a day. Some of it is important. Some of it is trivial. The key is to know what you can abandon to run the race better. Start with your faith in God. If there is anything essential in life, it is that. Then work your way out. How is God blessing you? How can you be a blessing from God to your family, your church, your community? I love God with all my heart and then I love others as God loves me. Very quickly, the trivial reviews itself. Watching TV is fun, but that is trivial compared to taking a walk with family. Reading a magazine is fun, but it is trivial compared to studying God's Word.

There is a place in life for the trivial. I love watching sports on Sunday afternoon following church. However, if you have sacrificed the important for the trivial it might be time to reorient yourself. As we start to see summer close and autumn begin, my prayer is that you and I can find a healthy balance of the important and the not so important. My prayer is that we can run the race and find that finish line.


GOOD SAMARITAN FUND ~ of the Sandwich-Somonauk Area Churches


normal Fair money to depend on but our bills will still need to be paid. We will be looking for ways to supplement our income with various fundraisers. If you have any suggestions, please let us know.


