Greetings,

I grew up in the 80s & 90s with the introduction of the personal home computer. One of my favorite things to do on the computer was play a certain game. We did not have a family computer until I was 14 years old, but I would go to the town or school library on weekends or after school and play 'Where in the World is Carmen San Diego?' Maybe you remember the game, and maybe you don't, but the premise was easy. You were a detective hunting down the infamous criminal 'Carmen San Diego' and her ban of henchmen. If you have a child or grandchild that has not journeyed through Confirmation, but would like to, please contact Pastor Tom. We are beginning a confirmation class for the 2021-2022


school year. What is confirmation?

United Methodists use the term "confirmation" to mark the first time a baptized Christian publicly "confirms" their intention to live the vows of the baptismal and membership covenant and so becomes a professing member of the local congregation and The United Methodist Church. Basically, it is the time when a youth will learn about God, the church and the Bible to decide if they would like to claim the faith of their family as their own. If a youth completes confirmation and takes the vows of confirmation at the end, they become a full, equal member of the church. Confirmation will begin in September 2021 to June 2022. There will be an orientation meeting set up in late August for all interested confirmands and their families.



Starting Sunday, September 19th, join us at 9:00 am, in the chapel to study the Bible together. The first study will be Words of Life: Jesus and the Promise of the Ten Commandments Today by Adam Hamilton.

The book explores the 10 Commandments and their relevance for today. Please Contact Pastor Tom to reserve a copy of the book.



As noted before, the Sandwich Congregational Church began in Little Rock in 1853.

It was formed in the Reform tradition, that is the independence of the local congregation. Among the early resolution was this one regarding slavery – remember this was before the Civil War: "Holding as we do that enslaving of one part of the human race by another part is a gross violation of the laws of God and of the most precious and sacred rights of human nature, therefore, we resolve that we will

hold no fellowship with any church or persons guilty of this sin..."

When the war did break out, the church had started a new building, but '...as the new building could not be ready for occupancy for some time the church voted to allow the Rev. C.A. Harvey to go as a delegate for the Christian Commission of the Army (likely as a chaplain). He went to the Army of the Potomac, lying upon the James River in front of Richmond. He was absent seven weeks." 6 members served in the Union Army.

From that same period, here is another note, this time as to new members: "The first regular minister to the Sandwich church was the Rev. James Kilbourn...His earnest and faithful efforts continued for six years, during which time the church prospered and enjoyed several successful revival seasons. Eighty four persons were received into the church during his ministry.... 1857-1863". It can be noted that during the 2 ½ yr. ministry of the Rev. John W. Cass (terminated early due to tuberculosis) 121 persons were admitted to the church,,, 57 by profession of faith.



Dining Room (refill condiment counter, wipe tables and trays)

Floater (put anywhere needed)

"Back at the Range" (baking pies at the church, transporting pies to the fair)
