Greetings,

I write to you on the start of an unusual school year. My kids, along with all the kids in District 430 will begin school on September 8th. Many kids will be learning remotely. My kids join others in a hybrid model of 2 in-person days, and 3 remote learning days. Anna, our youngest took her big step in childhood last year by beginning kindergarten. In a normal year, September 2020 would be a joyous but comfortable moment. Our children would begin school for a new year of learning and adventure, but with a foundation of comfort and understanding due to their prior experience. Instead, we enter the school year like we are sending three children to school for the first time. There is excitement, yes, but also a lot of anxiety and nervousness.

New beginnings are exciting in the best of times. They are also scary, nerve racking, exhilarating, and fear inducing during times of hardship. However, a new experience is a moment of great opportunity. We cannot control the situations of the world around us, and those situations

can change at any point. We can control our attitude and actions. My children can grow and mature, trust and find joy; be challenged and overcome. They begin the school year with enormous possibility of growth and hope. I also begin the school year with an opportunity to face the situation head on as a parent and lean into my relationship with God as I navigate this new journey.

We are also at a time of new beginnings in the church as we begin a new fall. Isaiah reminds us that, "But now, O Lord, You are our father; we are the clay, and You our potter; and all we are the work of Your hand." God is molding us in His glorious image. Each day, each week, each month, each year brings a new time for us to be shaped by the one who created the heavens and the earth.

Our church is opening up with opportunities of worship, fellowship, discipleship, and service. How is God molding you this fall into connecting with Him, with the church, and with the world? I want you to read God's word with a new mind. I want you to break bread with a new heart. I want you to worship with a new spirit. Our church will strive to provide those opportunities. We will have small groups. We are being intentional about providing Sunday school for the children, the youth, and the adults. We are going to continue to find ministry in the community that is impactful and relevant.

This fall will continue to be different than the past. This will bring new anxiety and worry. However, it will bring new understanding and hope. This fall God will again provide His potter hands. Our church will be the spinning wheel. Will you be the clay? Let me leave you with this passage written by Irenaues from the 2nd Century.

It is not you who shape God; it is God that shapes you. If then you are the work of God, await the hand of the Artist who does all things in due season. Offer the Potter your heart, soft and tractable, and keep the form in which the Artist has fashioned you. Let your clay be moist, lest you grow hard and lose the imprint of the Potter's fingers.






