


Through faith, God will lead us through this wilderness, and we will come out on the other side stronger, not because of our actions, but because of God's grace. I leave you with this prayer.



- Phase 1: (Currently in phase 1) Online Worship. We will continue to offer worship online, and continue to meet through Zoom/Conference Calls for Bible study, devotionals, and meetings. Our church is currently able to have in person meetings of up to 10 people while practicing social distancing and positive health measures. Online meetings will continue to be preferred.
- Phase 2: Drive-In Church. We will have Sunday worship at 10am with everyone staying in their cars. People will hear by turning to the select radio station and a few members of the church will lead worship from the sidewalk (in view of everyone), providing music, the message, prayers, and sacraments. Communion will be provided following strict health measures and through a drive-thru method. Online worship will still be provided each Sunday. In person meetings can continue, but preference will be given to online meetings. (We hope to be in phase 2 at some point in June, but will follow the guidance and direction of the Northern IL Conference.
- Phase 3: Outdoor Church. We will worship together and in person during phase 3. However, our worship services will be outside in the back lawn. This will allow people to social distance in the placement of chairs. We will have drive-in church on any Sunday with bad weather. In person meetings will become the preferred form of gathering with social distancing and strong safety measures in place. Participants will be able to and welcomed to join any meeting through Zoom by teleconferencing into the meeting. The size of the gathering will be determined by State guidelines and Conference guidance.
- Phase 4: In-Person Worship in the Sanctuary. In phase four we will return to normal worship in our sanctuary. In person meetings will resume without limits on participants. However, there will be TBD modifications to worship (ie. if we are able to have choir, communal singing, etc.) and yet to be determined restrictions on communal meals.
- Phase 5: A return to a normal worshipping faith community with newly adapted changes to reflect the new realities of the current world (ie. A moratorium on shaking hands, exclusive use of communion cups instead of the practice of dipping bread into one chalice, etc.)

CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL IS NOW ONLINE





The first celebration of Father's Day is thought to have been in July 1908, in Fairmont, West Virginia. Grace Golden Clayton suggested the special observance to her pastor after a deadly explosion in a nearby town killed 361 men.

Soon after, Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane, Washington, wanted to show her gratitude to her father, who'd cared for the family after his wife died. Dodd asked her pastor to choose a June Sunday to honor all fathers, and he selected June 19, 1910.

In 1924, President Coolidge suggested that Father's Day become a national holiday. In 1966, President Johnson designated the third Sunday of June to be Father's Day. Six years later, President Nixon instituted Father's Day as a national observance.
